vigilant or anxious children for walks, play soccer with students at lunchtime, offer a listening ear to those experiencing bereavement, respond to emergency situations when teachers are tied up with their classes, and provide spiritual support to students when requested by their parents. While chaplains are not required to counsel students, they can connect children and families with specialised professional support when needed.

I have yet to meet a fellow educator or parent who does not value and appreciate the role chaplains play in our schools.”

As Trish says, the Chappie's assist in raising the funds to pay their own wages. This year the amount needed is \$130,000. Governments do provide assistance, but unfortunately it is not sufficient. Donations are welcome.
